**Sixth Grade**

- Dividers, 6 sets, 8 ½ x 11”
- 3- Three-ring hardcover binders w/pockets
- 1-Black/White speckled Mead 3 subject Composition Book-wide ruled
- Tissues, 2 large boxes
- 1- quart size baggies
- 4-3 hole pencil bag

**Eighth Grade**

- Dividers, 4 sets, 8 ½ x 11”
- 5- Three-ring hardcover binders w/pockets (1”)
- 1-Black/White speckled Mead 3 subject Composition Book-wide ruled
- Tissues, 1 large box
- 1- quart size baggies
